Purchased by the tribe in 2004 as an economic development project, the site currently is planted with an orchard of heirloom apple trees. A 1680 Occaneechi Village has been recreated on the site, and a 1940's era farm is being developed as an agritourism site. The land was formerly a tobacco farm.

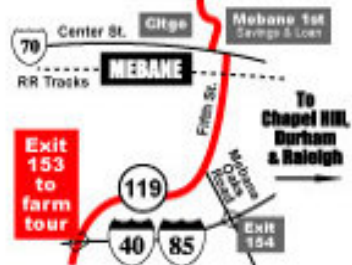
